

A regular session of the Grundy Center City Council was called to order at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, January 19, 2015, in the Council Chambers by Mayor Buhrow. Present: Hamann, Ammerman, Stefl and Kiewiet. Absent: Miller.

Stefl moved and Hamann seconded the approval of the meeting agenda. Motion carried four ayes.

Stefl moved and Kiewiet seconded the consent agenda consisting of: approval of the minutes of the regular session held January 5, 2015; approval of the December 2014 Investment and Treasurer Report. Motion carried four ayes.

Mayor Buhrow opened the public forum at 6:32 p.m. No public comments made.

Hamann moved and Stefl seconded action on the Second Reading of Ordinance 516, an ordinance amending the zoning ordinance for the City of Grundy Center for 706 H Avenue, Grundy Center from an R-1 property to a C-2 property. Motion carried with four ayes.

Hamann moved and Stefl seconded action on Resolution 2015-02, a resolution approving the voluntary annexation request from Creekside, Inc. Motion carried four ayes.

Stefl moved and Kiewiet seconded the approval of Mayor Buhrow appointment of Nathan Kappel to the Ambulance Board for a three year term ending December 31, 2017. Motion carried four ayes.

Kiewiet moved and Ammerman seconded the approval of Mayor Buhrow appointment of Lori Burmester to the Board of Adjustments for a five year term ending December 31, 2019. Motion carried four ayes.

Finance Committee made no comments.

Safety Committee made no comments.

Public Works Committee made comments that they survived the first snowstorm and first water main break of this winter; rough week at the wastewater plant with a malfunctioning valve which has now been repaired; and working on next fiscal year budgets.

Mayor Buhrow made comment that the subcommittee is still looking at utility bills for the Upper Elementary Building. No decisions have been made. Stefl made comment that he was approached by a resident concerned about the school situation and they would be interested in helping the City financially with the Upper Elementary Building.

Stefl moved and Kiewiet seconded adjournment of the meeting. Motion carried four ayes.
