

A regular session of the Grundy Center City Council was called to order at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, September 22, 2014, in the Council Chambers by Mayor Buhrow. Present: Stefl, Hamann, and Ammerman. Absent: Miller and Kiewiet

Stefl moved and Kiewiet seconded the approval of the meeting agenda. Motion carried three ayes.

Hamann moved and Stefl seconded the consent agenda consisting of: approval of the minutes of the regular session held September 8, 2014; approval of Treasurers & Investments Report for August 2014; approval for street closure for the homecoming parade on Sunday, September 28, 2014 from 4-8pm, 7th Street from G Avenue to H Avenue; and approval for street closure for the Girls Night Out Event on Thursday, October 16, 2014 from 5-8pm, 7th Street from G Avenue to H Avenue including three parking spots along G Avenue. Motion carried three ayes.

Hamann moved and Stefl seconded action on Resolution 2014-50 authorizing the Clerk to submit the Street Financial Report to the Iowa Department of Transportation. Motion carried with three ayes.

Public Works Committee reported light project is progressing with light poles being installed along north side of G Avenue and seal-coating project will begin later this week on the northeast side of the city and around the aquatic center.
