

A regular session of the Grundy Center City Council was called to order at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, November 18, 2013, in the Council Chambers by Pro Tem Mayor Stefl. Present: Hamann, Buhrow and Miller. Absent: Mayor Van Wert and one seat vacant.

Pro Tem Mayor Stefl requested action on meeting agenda, Buhrow moved and Hamann seconded to accept the agenda as written. Motion carried four ayes.

Miller moved and Hamann seconded the approval of the consent agenda consisting of: approval of the minutes of the regular session held November 6, 2013; and approval of the Treasurers and Investments Report for October 2013. Motion carried four ayes.

Pro Tem Mayor Stefl opened the public forum at 6:33 p.m. Justin Lynch spoke to the City Council about the need to have a bonded contractor with certain insurance coverage for the Street Lighting project for G Avenue. Steve Hinderhoffer also offered thanks to each council member for all the hard work put in to running the city. Forum closed at 6:38 p.m.

Buhrow moved and Miller seconded action to approve the submittal of the Annual Urban Renewal Report to the State of Iowa. Motions carried with four ayes.

Miller moved and Buhrow seconded action to approve a temporary street closing request by the Chamber and Village of Lights Committee for Saturday, November 23, 2013 from 5-7:30pm. They are requesting that 7<sup>th</sup> Street be closed from G Avenue to H Avenue and that 8<sup>th</sup> Street be closed from G Avenue North to the alley. Motion carried with four ayes.

The finance committee informed council of Kendra Lufkin started her position as Deputy City Clerk today.

The safety committee made no comment.

The Public Works Director updated the Council that once details are finalized for the Street Lighting Project, request for proposals will be sent out to contractors.

At 7:05 p.m. Hamann moved and Miller seconded adjournment of the meeting. Motion carried four ayes.
